# Superintendent's Notes

....From Wade Toeplitz

Brrr! It's been a very cold January so far. Thankfully it's almost over, and we have only one more month of this to endure. February is always a contender for some serious winter storm. I feel like I've barely seen any golfers these last few weeks. Come on Spring, so we can get some play going again.

I can say that this has been an easier winter for me than the last three I've been here. With the addition of the greens covers it really sets our minds at ease. We have installed covers twice so far this month and we get better each time. The crew and volunteers really do a great job. It may even be kind of fun. I appreciate them giving up a Saturday afternoon and some of their evening to come out and help. A special thank you to Matt and Jamison Webb as well as Neil White for coming out to help. Many have asked how they are working. I would say great. Outside temps were 20 this week in the mornings and the greens soil temperature averaged 35/36 degrees. That's pretty amazing.

Lots of work has been going on in the shop. Oil, air and fuel filters changed on almost everything. Carts are being repaired as needed, and we were donated several tires for them. The greens mowers reels are getting some serious work done for the upcoming season. Brand new reels are going to help us get our greens to the desired height of cut we wanted last season. They were just too worn to achieve that. Trinten and Thomas have done a great job learning how to really dial these in. Fresh new reels should make for a great putting surface. Of course, we will still have to keep on our other cultural practices to achieve that. Lots of dethatching and aerifications this season. If we plan on pulling cores we will notify in advance.

There are still several things on my list to accomplish outside this winter but it truly has just been too cold or windy. Those don't mix with several projects, but we will have it looking great this spring. It already is in comparison to last year at this time; it looks so much better and healthy.

Reminder that members meetings will be starting soon, and we will be closing the course every Tuesday for maintenance. This will be a tremendous help to us. As usual, thank you all! Stay safe and warm.
